



## 2006 Sales Tax Holidays

State	Tax Rate	Items Exempted	2006 Dates
<a href="#">AL</a>	4.0%	Computers or software up to \$750 per item, clothing less than \$100 per article, school supplies up to \$50 per item, or books up to \$30 each	8/4-8/6
<a href="#">CT</a>	6%	Clothing and footwear sold up to \$300 (replaces the exemption on clothing and footwear sold for less than \$50 in place the rest of the year)	8/20-8/26
<a href="#">DC</a>	5.75%	School supplies, clothing, accessory items and shoes for up to \$100 per item	8/5-8/13
<a href="#">FL</a> *	6.0%	Books, clothing, footwear and certain accessories up to \$50, and school supplies up to \$10	7/22-7/30
<a href="#">GA</a>	4.0%	School supplies sold up to \$20, clothing and footwear up to \$100, computers and peripherals, and energy-efficient appliances up to \$1,500	8/3-8/6
<a href="#">IA</a>	5.0%	Clothing or footwear sold up to \$100, and some clothing accessories	8/4-8/5
<a href="#">MD</a>	5.0%	Clothing and footwear up to \$100 per item	8/23-8/27
<a href="#">MA</a>	5.0%	All purchases of up to \$2,500	8/12-8/13
<a href="#">MO</a>	4.225%	Clothing and footwear up to \$100, school supplies up to \$50 per item software up to \$350, and computers and computer peripherals up to \$3,500	8/4-8/6
<a href="#">NM</a>	5.0%	Clothing or footwear up to \$100, computers up to \$1,000, computer peripherals up to \$500, school supplies priced up to \$15, and book bags, backpacks, handheld calculators, maps up to \$100	8/4-8/6
<a href="#">NC</a>	4.5%	Clothing and school supplies up to \$100, sports gear up to \$50, computers up to \$3,500 or less, and computer supplies up to \$250	8/4-8/6
<a href="#">SC</a>	5.0%	Clothing, clothing accessories, footwear, school supplies, computers, computer peripherals and software, and linens for the bed and bath	8/4-8/6
<a href="#">TN</a>	7.0%	Clothing and school supplies priced up to \$100 and computers up to \$1,500	8/4-8/6
<a href="#">TX</a>	6.25%	Most clothing and footwear up to \$100	8/4-8/6
<a href="#">VA</a>	4.0%	Clothing and footwear up to \$100 and school supplies up to \$20	8/4-8/6

Note: For more information about a specific state, simply click on the above abbreviation. "Tax Rate" refers to the state sales tax rate. All dates are in month/day form.

*Florida:* The state also offers a sales tax holiday for hurricane preparedness supplies purchased between 5/21-6/1 and for the purchase of energy efficient appliances between 10/5-10/11 up to \$1,500.
